# Secretary Report – July 2018 District Meeting

The District 12 meeting was held at Queen Street in Morganton. There were 19 voting members. The meeting was opened with the Serenity Prayer.

SECRETARY – Lory read last month's minutes, which were accepted.

TREASURER – Dean reviewed the treasurer's report, which was accepted. Mary and Donna asked about frequency of donations to World Services, which became a motion to pay \$550 to both Area and WSO, which passed. A minority spoke about wanting to keep \$200 over prudent reserve, and after discussion, another motion was passed to adjust the amount to \$450.

DCM – Marty discussed the Spring Assembly, reviewed agenda items and thanked the district for support. He shared flyers about the State Convention and Fall Assembly.

ALT DCM – Debbie also shared her gratitude for the district support and the wonderful attendance at the Assembly.

LCM BURKE – Byron shared again that Queen Street is still open Saturday mornings from 8 – 12 noon for coffee, donuts, sponsorship meetings, and fellowship, with a meeting at 10 am.

LCM CATAWBA – Open position. Marty explained duties of position.

LCM CALDWELL – Eric stated that he has been to all the county meetings, and he has nothing to report.

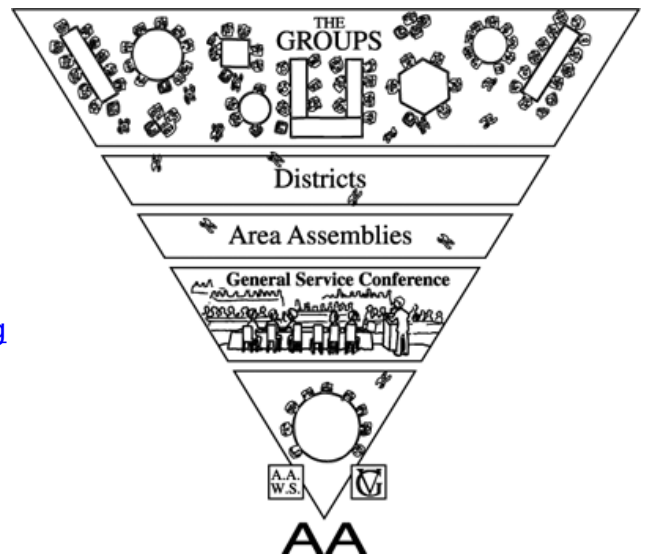

# Corrections Article for Volunteers

We have a urgent need for support in the area correctional facilities. At this time there are a total of 4 volunteers for the Caldwell unit, 2 for the Catawba Unit and none for the Burke Units. Actually the Burke units do not have any active meetings so that is an urgent need for some folks to get that going again.

The process for volunteering is simple. Fill out an application and mail it to the facility you want to volunteer at. It can take several months to be approved so be patient. The general guidelines are not to have any pending legal charges and be off any probation or parole supervision for 12 months. One year sober time is also suggested.

What can you do if you cannot volunteer or have other issues?

- 1: Offer to speak at a correctional setting. (You can go in one time a year as a visitor.)
- 2: Volunteer to be a temporary contact upon an inmate's release and take them to their first outside A.A. meeting.
- 3: Provide the correctional facilities, with their permission, with DVDs of A.A. material.
- 4: Donate the price of a Big Book and the Twelve and Twelve to your local corrections committee, as well as back issues of the Grapevine and A.A. Conference- approved literature.
- 5: Correspond with an inmate through the Corrections Correspondence Service.
- 6: Support your district, area or intergroup/central office correctional facilities committees. Participate in correctional facilities workshops

**Remember**—when anyone, anywhere reaches out for help, I want the hand of A.A. always to be there—FOR THAT I AM RESPONSIBLE. They can not have a meeting without a volunteer present. One is all it takes.
